



Print the provided template on a color printer. On a color photocopier, enlarge 200%. The enlarged strips should be $2\frac{3}{4}$ x $10\frac{1}{2}$ inches. Cut along the outside edges of the strips. Fold down a quarter-inch on one end of the strip, width-wise so the color is on the outside of the fold. Keep folding in quarter-inch increments, accordion-style, down the length of the strip. The final fold should have the color on the outside. If there is any short end left on the final fold making it uneven, trim it off. Push the accordion together and fold at the middle. Work the fold back and forth at the middle so the folded accordion is flexible. Pinch two ends together to form a fanned half-circle. Pinch the two other ends together so you create a fanned full circle. Glue ends to secure. Depending on the number of folds, you may need to secure the center of the medallion with glue, as well.
